GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Management reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show. The MJMHA Classic Horse Show reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and to cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards of prizes, without claims for damages. Sections may be combined or canceled if there are insufficient entries. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, its decision to be final.

Corrections to this prize list will appear on the MMHJA website.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding Classes.

AGE OF RIDER

The age of an individual on December 1 will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. (GR103) Amateur rider/driver/handler must be at least 18 years old.

Ladies and Gentlemen rider/driver must be at least 18 years old.

Youth rider/driver must be 21 years old or younger.

Amateur Masters riders must be 50 years old or older.

ARENAS, WARM UP & EXERCISE AREAS

The Footing in all arenas consists of a mixture of clay, sand and wood shavings.

Show ring: 110' x 220'

Dressage ring: 20 x 60 meters

Lunging is not allowed in the show arena at any time. You may lunge in the make-up rings up to 1 hours prior to each session. Turnout is not allowed in any arena at any time.

The show arena is available for daily practice sessions up to one hour before each session. There will be 30 minutes of quiet time for working horses in the show ring every day of the show following the final class of the morning session. During this time, no popping of lash whips, use of powder or plastic bags, or any other noise-making device will be allowed in the show ring.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Horses will be admitted to the Ingham County Fairgrounds beginning on Wednesday April 19. Early move in on Wednesday at 9:00AM is available for an additonal \$25 per stall, and will be charged for all stalls in the group. Regular move in begins at 5:00PM. Any exhibitor arriving prior to this time with horses will be turned away. Horses must be entered in at least one class to be admitted to the Ingham County Fairgrounds. All horses shall leave the Ingham County Fairgrounds no later than 10:00 P.M. Sunday, April 23, 2023.

ATTENTION GETTING DEVICES AND FORBIDDEN APPLIANCES

Attention-getting devices and/or other noisemakers (including but not limited to tape measures, blow horns, altered bamboo poles, explosives, etc.) are not allowed in and around the makeup/ schooling/ warm-up and competition rings during the scheduled competition sessions. Use of explosives and fire extinguishers by or for exhibitors/competitors (except in the case of fire) are not allowed on competition grounds at any time.

ATTIRE AND ENTRANCE TO RING

All riders/drivers/handlers, attendants and awards presenters must be neatly and appropriately attired to enter the show ring for all performances or may be denied entrance.

CAMPING

All campers and motor homes will be charged for camping. If you put a plug into an electrical outlet you will be charged for camping. There is no saving of camping spaces, sites are first come first serve. \$85 flat fee if paid by the entry deadline, \$100 after the deadline. Fee may be refunded if you notify the secretary 24 hours before horses are admitted. You must display your camper permit. Camping allowed in designated areas only, there is no camping against the Dickerson Barn. Tampering with electrical equipment or unauthorized connections shall be fined \$500 per occurrence.

CANCELATION OR COMBINING OF CLASSES

The show reserves the right to cancel any class where there are less than three entries. They also may combine or divide any classes should the best interest of the show require it. In case of cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded.

CHECKS RETURNED/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS

All checks returned for insufficient funds or credit cards declined for any reason will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified check or cashier's check. No one will be allowed to show if he/she has a returned check, declined credit card or handling fee outstanding. A \$30.00 per horse late fee will be added to entries made with a check returned for any reason.

CROSS ENTERING

Cross-entering is NOT allowed between the Classic Pleasure (Driving or Saddle) Sections and the English Pleasure or Pleasure Driving Sections, but Cross-entering between the Classic Pleasure Sections and all other Sections is allowed.

DOGS AND OTHER PETS

Dogs, or other pets, are not permitted to be loose at any time (arrival to departure) on competition grounds. Dogs, or other pets, must be kept contained, or on a leash no greater than 6 feet in length under the immediate control of a responsible person and shall not be allowed to disturb or annoy visitors. The Ingham County Animal Control Ordinance and State Dog Law shall be strictly enforced. A \$50 fine will be charged for any dog SEEN loose on the show grounds. The person that owns or is in immediate charge of any dog shall immediately remove all droppings and deposit in trash receptacle on competition grounds. If no receptacle is available, droppings are to be taken off competition grounds and disposed of. Dog, or other pet, owners failing to comply will be subject to penalty.

DISCIPLINE

Exhibitors are warned that any action of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, rider, or driver, will disqualify the horse. Exhibitors will be held fully responsible for any damage or discourtesy caused by their employees or guests. The Management reserves the right to remove any groom, horse, rider, or driver from the show, without being liable for compensation. No exhibitor shall approach a Judge with regard to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the show manager who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place and under no circumstances, while any session of the show is in progress. Exhibitors are to refrain from fraternizing with the Judges at any time before or during the show.

DRESSAGE

All tests will be ridden in a standard size (20x60m) arena, unless entries are such that the small arena must be used for intro levels for timing purposes. Intro, Training, Western Intro and Western Basic levels will be divided into Open, Junior and Adult Amateur divsions. Championships will be awarded for each level and divison and will be based on the riders 2 highest scores. USDF and WDAA memberships are not required. Post entries will only be accepted if there is available space. Ride times will be posted in the office by Thursday evening. Best efforts will be made to accommodate riders competing in the main and dressage rings, but cannot be guaranteed. MJMHA offers year end awards for dressge, be sure to sign up prior to or during the show for your points to count.

ENTRIES

One owner per Entry Blank.

Entry Blanks must be completed in full, signed and accompanied by full payment, copies of registration papers. Riders in medal classes must be UPHA or AMHA members. Memberships will be verified electronically; however, you may be required to present a copy of your card or papers if they are unable to be verified.

Cash, check or credit card may be used to pay for entries.

If the owner or exhibitor is under 18 years of age, the Entry Blank must be signed by a representative who is of age and who, by such a signature, individually assumes responsibility and risk as stated above the signature. The Show assumes no responsibility, and this shall be a condition of entry.

Closing Date of Entries: ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY April 12, 2024.

Entries after this date will be assessed a one-time \$30 per horse late entry fee. Post entries must be made at least one hour prior to the session in which the class will be contested. No additional charge will be made for entries in Championship classes; however, the entry must be placed at least one hour before the start of the session in which it is shown. *Dressage post entries will be accepted based upon availability*.

No horse will be allowed to enter the show ring without having a back number issued and a payment on file in the show office. Exhibitors will be required to present their health and Coggins certificates and any other necessary information in order to receive back numbers.

The Board of Directors of the Michigan Justin Morgan Horse Association, Inc. (MJMHA) forbids any legal entity or individual with outstanding debts to the Association from showing at the Michigan All Morgan Horse Show. All debts must be settled with the Michigan All Morgan Horse Show Manager. These individuals, their family members, employees, and any horse owned, leased, or shown by them will not be allowed to enter the show arena. Additionally, the MJMHA reserves the right to refuse any entry.

FEED AND BEDDING

Shavings will be available on the grounds for purchase through Crestview Tack Shop, ask for Steve 517-676-3410. Shavings must be ordered by 4/13 to guarantee delivery to stalls. ALL BEDDING USED MUST BE A WOOD BY-PRODUCT. STRAW IS NOT TO BE USED AT ANYTIME. YOU WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$150.00 PER STALL IF YOUR STALL HAS ANY NON WOOD PRODUCT IN IT.

HEADERS

Headers in the Morgan Division must be a minimum of 16 years of age and dressed appropriately (USEF horse show age, see GR103).

HEADGEAR

Riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear with properly fitting harness in the following: All classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds. (exception: Trail classes).

Hunter Seat Equitation classes, including Walk/Trot

Dressage riders when warming up for and riding in Dressage classes (exception: Western Dressage) Lead-Line riders at all times when mounted.

Protective headgear is acceptable in any other division or class without penalty by the judge. See GR801.4.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Vaccinations: Horses more than seven months of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. All horses

must have a negative coggins dated within 1 year of the start date of the show.

HEARING DEVICES

Electronic communication devices used for purposes of coaching exhibitors during a competition are prohibited in all classes. Exhibitors with a permanent hearing impairment are permitted to use an electronic communication device upon submission of a written certification from a treating medical professional's office certifying the permanent hearing impairment and certifying the requirement of an electronic communication device. The medical certification must be provided to the competition management, within a reasonable time prior to competing.

HOLDS

All holds must be requested at the horse show office a minimum of 1 hour prior to the start of the session in which the hold is needed. All holds will be 2 minutes in length.

LIABILITY

Under the Michigan Equine Activity Liability Act, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity.

The MJMHA Classic Horse Show, MJMHA and Ingham County Fairgrounds will in no way be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and furthermore it will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, trainer, owner, rider, groom and/or agent shall hold the horse show and its management blameless for any loss or accident to his or her horses that may occur from sickness, accident or any other cause. Additionally, The Michigan All Morgan Horse Show, MJMHA, AMHA, USDF and Ingham County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for any article of any kind that may be lost, destroyed, or stolen and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, employees, spectators, or any other interested parties. GOLF CARTS, SCOOTERS AND OTHER MOTORIZED VEHICLES: All drivers must be licensed and must not exceed the seating capacity of the vehicle. No motorized vehicles will be allowed in any building during horse show hours, except on move in and move out days.

USEF Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

STATE LAW- NO SMOKING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS

PREMIUMS AND AWARDS

All prize money will be mailed to the owner of record within 30 days after the show.

Prize money will be withheld from exhibitors who do not have a clear account.

All class winners will receive a ribbon.

PERSONS NOT IN GOOD STANDING

The Board of Directors of the Michigan Justin Morgan Horse Association, Inc. (MJMHA) forbids any legal entity or individual with outstanding debts to the Association from showing at the MJMHA Classic Horse Show. All debts must be settled with the show manager. These individuals, their family members, employees, and any horse owned, leased, or shown by them will not be allowed to enter the show arena.

QUALIFICATION

Amateur classes are restricted to Amateurs 18 years and over. Junior Exhibitors will qualify for amateur championships when no junior exhibitor championship is offered, however they will be judged by amateur class specifications.

Ladies and Gentleman's classes will qualify for their respective amateur championships if shown by an amateur in the qualifying class.

MJMHA Medal Classes will qualify the rider for the respective equitation championship.

No classes will be required to strip.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be issued only if requested in writing prior to the closing date of entry, less the \$25 office fee. Any request to withdraw horses after the closing date (April 12, 2024) of entries, will be considered on a case by case basis and will be a refund of class fees only. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON AFTER April 16, 2024 without proper documentation from the Veterinarian. NO REFUNDS will be made if an exhibitor misses a class for any reason and the class has not been properly scratched in the show office prior to the session in which the class occurred.

SCRATCHES AND ADDS

Any class entered or scratched during the show must be entered ONE HOUR before the session in which the class is to be held. You will be charged for any class which is not scratched properly in the office prior to the session.

SHARPS DISPOSAL

Safe and proper sharps disposal (needles, syringes and other hazardous objects and materials) is the responsibility of individual stables. Containers are available throughout the stabling area.

STABLING

Stalls are mandatory for all horses. No showing from trailers. Stalls are approximately 10'x10', have doors, and are solid on the bottom half with bars on the top. Stalls are \$75 each with move in after 5PM on Wednesday April 20. Early move in is \$25 per stall, available at 9:00 AM on Wednesday. NO STALLS ARE TO BE TAKEN APART. Inspections will be made during the show. If any STALL is DISMANTLED, YOU will be CHARGED \$150.00 per occurrence. All shavings bags <u>MUST</u> be tied into bundles & placed in or by trash. All bedding must be a wood by product. No straw is allowed. Any stall with manure in it is a HORSE STALL and the SHOW will be CHARGED accordingly. Any stall with as little as twine or paper left in it will be charged \$50 extra for clean-up. Please contact the stabling manager with your stall counts by the closing date of entries. All stabling assignments and counts become final the Monday prior to the show. You will be charged for all stalls reserved by this date.

VETERINARIAN'S HOURS

The Veterinarian's on-call telephone number will be posted in the Show Office or available from the Barn Manager.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

MORGAN DIVISION

USEF (Chapter MO) EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Specifically, Chapter MO; Morgan Horse Division.

Horses shown in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered names or if under one year of age be eligible for registration. Canadian horses born before January 1, 1985 must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or have Canadian Morgan Horse Club registration papers showing as American registration number. Canadian horses born after January 1, 1985 can be shown with Canadian Registration papers as long as the papers do not state "not eligible for U.S. reciprocity".

Stallions are prohibited in Ladies and Junior Exhibitor classes. One attendant without whip must head each horse in the Park Harness and Pleasure Driving classes. Cross entering is allowed between Classic Pleasure and all other English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving provided requirements are met with USEF.

1. In order to compete, all horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred. Registry or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the names of the owner(s) of record with the A.S.R. or the C.L.R.C.

2. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership, or a copy of the registration papers with a Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the American Saddlebred Registry must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry or presented to competition office before competition number will be released; competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. See GR1309.2a(5). Exception: Horses shown in any USEF Regular Competition prior to December 31, 1979, and Saddlebred-type ponies.




